Mailing of Sample Ballot Booklets and Election Ballots *2015 Glendale Municipal Election*

GLENDALÉ, CA. (March 13, 2015) – The Glendale City Clerk’s Office announces that the City’s Municipal Election sample ballot booklets were mailed to voters on March 9, 2015. Permanent Vote-by-Mail ballots were mailed to voters on Wednesday, March 11, 2015. The sample ballot booklets feature candidates for Glendale City Council, Glendale Community College Board of Trustees, and Glendale Unified School District Board, along with four measures. Those wishing to vote in the Glendale Election must complete their ballots and return them by mail or in person at any Glendale polling location by Tuesday, April 7, 2015.

All sample ballot books are published in English, Armenian, Korean, Spanish, and Tagalog. Anyone requesting further assistance may find informational and instructional videos in these five languages along with digital copies of the sample ballot on the City’s Election website at www.GlendaleVotes.org.

Voters are urged to make certain that their Vote-by-Mail envelope is signed and the ballot is returned to the City of Glendale Election Center’s P.O. Box listed on the return envelope.

Election Day is on Tuesday, April 7, 2015. Voters have to opportunity to vote for up to two candidates for each of the following bodies – Glendale City Council, Glendale Community College Board of Trustees, and Glendale Unified School District Board. Additionally, voters will be considering three amendments to the charter (Measures C, D, and E), along with Measure O.
